

## Measures to reduce the spread of infection.

*We attach importance to having routines to reduce the risk of spreading infections and therefore follow daily decisions and recommendations from the Swedish Public Health Agency, the Swedish government, and the local Region. We stick to the facts and what we know.*

*This applies to accommodation and restaurants.*

- All our rooms in the hotel and all but four in the hostel have a private bathroom.
- We limit the number of guests who can stay in our lounges at the same time.
- There are hand sanitizers in all rooms and at many places.
- We regularly spray exposed places such as credit card holders, public handles, toilets etc.
- We serve our meals at buffets, according to directives from the Swedish Public health Agency where the following is stated: *If it is possible to let guests order and pick up their food and drink themselves, it is allowed, if it does not get crowded or leads to queues.*
- We have reduced the number of seats in the dining room and in several other rooms to half.
- If necessary, we introduce sitting times for breakfast and dinner. The restaurant closes at 20:00 according to directive from the Swedish government.
- Guests belonging to the same party can sit 4 people together. Then there should be at least one meter distance to the next group of guests.
- We use two different dining rooms when we have many guests.
- In other respects, everyone, staff and guests in our area, themselves must take responsibility for keeping distance, washing their hands often and staying in their accommodation when they feel ill in some way.

*This applies to ski slopes and trails.*

We follow recommendations linked to lifts and how to handle if there is a ski accident.

- Meeting places for the ski school are sparsely populated.
- We encourage guests to go skiing only with their travel companion.
- We have extra-long and wide queue hems to avoid queue accumulations at the lift.
- We urge guests to keep their distance in any lift queues.
- We have webcams in several places around the mountain to be able to easily follow up any queues connected to our lifts.
- We have minimized the number of places indoors our rest rooms and huts.
- There are hand sanitizers in rest rooms, huts and toilets.
